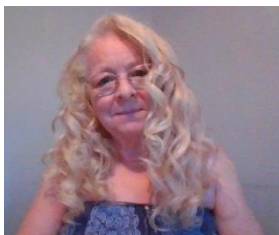

**THE EILEEN SENIOR BURSARY**

The 'Eileen Senior Bursary' was established by the Jersey Eisteddfod in 2009 following a bequest by the late Eileen Senior, a much respected teacher of speech and drama on the Island.

This cash bursary is available to students over the age of 16, who have a guaranteed place at an accredited Drama or Performing Arts School and is intended to help with expenses such as study materials, books and theatre visits.

Interested students who must have entered solo classes in the English, Speech and Drama Section of the Eisteddfod for at least 3 years are invited to apply in writing to The Bursary Committee, La Valette, La Ruelle, St Lawrence, JE3 1HT, by 31st December 2023.

Applicants should include brief information about themselves, what they hope to achieve through further training and why they think they should be awarded this bursary.
