EXHIBITS: 2D work and 3D pieces in ceramics and mixed media may be entered.

Due to the space requirements in the hall, we need to restrict the number of entries as follows:

A maximum of 15 pieces **per school** in the 2D Section. Preferably 1 entry per child. **Each school will be allocated a display board, measuring 46" wide and 71" high.**

A Maximum of 10 pieces **per school** in the 3D Section - Preferably 1 entry per child.

Each school will be allocated a display area measuring 36" x 30"

Three of the 10 pieces may be made from recycled material.

Due to limited space in the exhibition area, free-standing items cannot be accommodated.

Velcro will be provided on site; however, if you wish to prepare this beforehand, it can be obtained from 'Paperclix' at Sandybrook.

To protect the material on the boards, no other fixings may be used.

No Nursery items (under the age of 4)

Children's names should be printed in block capitals on the 'competitor list of names, and the lists must be handed in with the entries on the school set up days.

Exhibits may not be removed from the Exhibition before 4.00 p.m. on Sunday 10th March without the prior written authority of the Chairman or appointed representative of the relevant Section and may then be removed only on presentation of proof of identity.
