Adjudicator

Bryan Husband, GRSM(Hons), ADWCMD, FISM

Bryan studied at the Royal College of Music, London, and the Welsh College of Music and Drama in Cardiff. Bryan has homes in London and Worcester, having spent some years abroad, performing in continental opera houses. He is a Vocal Professor at Trinity Laban, runs a private practice, gives workshops ('belting' to audition techniques), performs, adjudicates, and works as a ski instructor! Performances include TV and radio broadcasts, opera, oratorio and recital.

In 2005, Bryan was selected to become an adjudicator for The British and International Federation of Festivals. Adjudication has taken him to many Festivals around the UK and Ireland, and also to Hong Kong, Gibraltar and Trinidad & Tobago. In 2012, Bryan was invited to become a music examiner; his most recent examining work was in Malaysia for classical music, and Thailand for Rock and Pop.

His hobbies include all theatre, gardening, skiing and walking.



New Marking System

The Jersey Eisteddfod Festivals of Performing Arts have introduced the new marking system as proposed by the British and International Federation of Festivals.

We believe the new marking scheme will give more differentiation and a greater accuracy of the calibre of an individual performance compared with other performances nationally.

The categories are as follows and will include two new certificates - JADE, for the 'Developing' level and DIAMOND for the 'Exceptional' level.

65-69 Developing – Jade Certificate - A performance demonstrating an awareness of technical skills, requiring more consistency & artistry

70-74 Progressing – Copper Certificate - A performance showing development of technique and/or communication and commitment

75-79 Merit – Bronze Certificate - A competent performance, showing some artistic awareness and/or technical ability

80-84 Commended – Silver Certificate - A convincing performance technically & artistically, with increasing stylistic & communication skills

85-89 Honours – Gold Certificate - An excellent performance, demonstrating fluent technical and artistic skills with emerging individuality

90-94 Outstanding – Platinum Certificate - An impressive performance technically and artistically, displaying spontaneity & clear individuality

95+ Exceptional – Diamond Certificate - A superlative performance, displaying exceptional artistic individuality
