



## PRIMARY SCHOOL ART & CRAFT SYLLABUS 2026

2D work and/or 3D pieces in ceramics and mixed media may be entered.

Due to the space requirements in the hall, we need to restrict the number of entries as follows:

- A maximum of 15 pieces **per school** in the 2D Section. Preferably 1 entry per child. **Each school will be allocated a display board, measuring 46" wide and 71" high.**
- A Maximum of 10 pieces **per school** in the 3D Section - Preferably 1 entry per child. **Each school will be allocated a display area measuring 36" x 30".** We encourage the use of recycled material.
- Free-standing items cannot be accommodated.
- No Nursery items (under the age of 4)

Children's names should be printed in block capitals on the 'competitor list of names, and the lists must be handed in with the entries on the school set up days.

Exhibits may not be removed from the Exhibition before 4.00 p.m. on Sunday 15th March without the prior written authority of the Chairman or appointed representative of the relevant Section and may then be removed only on presentation of proof of identity.

Each school is responsible for setting up their own display. Each school will be allocated a screen for displaying 2D entries and, if relevant a table for 3D & recycled entries.

Velcro, for attaching artwork to the screens, will be available at RJA & HS on the set-up days. However, if you wish to prepare this beforehand, it can be obtained from 'Paperclix' at Sandybrook. To protect the material on the boards, no other fixings may be used.
